This will include, but is not limited to: Suicidal subjects; barricaded or trapped criminals; hostage versus non-hostage situation; etc. Students will also learn to identify the prevalent mental disorders that are encountered in crisis situations. This class will also teach the concepts of communication skills (active listening), intelligence gathering, tactical use of the negotiator, surrender phase, and the other procedures to reach a positive conclusion to situations they may encounter in their law enforcement career.

Student's participation in role-playing exercises is a requirement of this course.
